We are also grateful for Eldon Olsen who, though retired from a career in public works, has volunteered many hours to Mayfield to help monitor the water system and complete testing to verify that the water is safe.

We will need to appoint a council person to fill the council seat vacated by Jaden James. Amanda has posted that information. This seat will also be part of this mid-year election cycle; thus, we will have on the ballot 2 council seats that are part of the regular election cycle, and a third one that will fill the final two years of the term that Jaden had.

2023 Mayfield Town Municipal Election

Election for **3 Councilmember seats**- 1 seat 4-year term
1 seat 2-year term
1 seat 2-year term*
*(to fill a mid-term vacancy)

Municipal Primary Election Day: August 15, 2023
General Municipal Election Day: November 7, 2023

Qualification to Run for Municipal Office

- All interested qualified residents must file for candidacy with the Mayfield Town Clerk during normal business hours.
- Dates for filing candidacy are June 1st thru June 7th 2023 by 5:00 PM
- A qualified resident of Mayfield can become a candidate for office by filling out a "Declaration of Candidacy" for themselves, or by having another resident of the town gather signatures on a Nomination Petition. No filing fee is required to file for candidacy.
- Qualifications of a candidate are:
 - Must be a registered voter of Mayfield Town. (US citizen 18 years old or older.)
 - Must have resided in Mayfield for 12 consecutive months immediately preceding the date of election.
 - In case of annexation, any person who has resided within the territory annexed for the prescribed 12- month period is deemed to meet the residency requirements for candidates.
 - Any mentally incompetent person, any person convicted of a felony, or any person convicted of treason or a crime against the elective franchise may not hold office in this State until the right to vote or hold elective office has been restored.
 - A person may be a candidate for only one office at any one election.
