Included with your bill this month is information and a survey regarding culinary water connections. We ask all of you to complete this so we can accurately maintain our cross connection control program. There are a couple ways to do this:

- (1) complete the enclosed form and return it by Nov. 30th
- (2) visit our website at <u>mayfieldtown.org</u> and click on 'Cross Connection Control Survey' at the top of the home page, this will open the survey for you to submit online by Nov. 30th.

If you have a testable backflow preventer, you are required to have it tested annually by a certified technician. Copies of the test results must be sent to Mayfield town.

(if you have multiple residential water connections, one survey per residence is required,
