Mayor's Corner

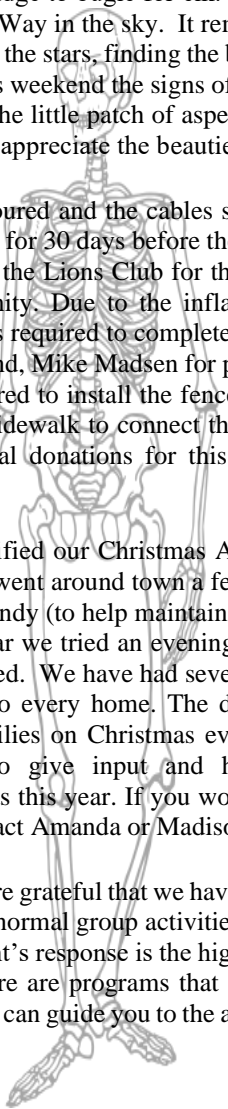

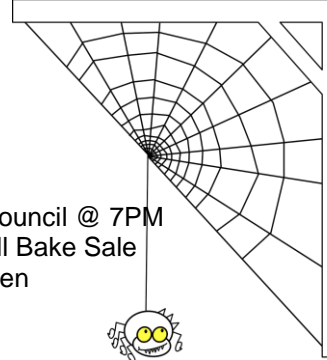
